- 4.) Chair's Report by Tanja Scekic Ivkovic (PAC Chair)
  - General Meeting was held online (Zoom) on October 24th at 6:30 8:00 pm
    PAC had a busy month and several events since the last meeting Pumpkin Patch and Hot Chocolate Day on Monday October 30th.
  - PAC Funded the event paid \$3330 for the pumpkins (1100 pumpkins at \$3 plus \$30 delivery) and \$355.00 for the hot chocolate and marshmallows (including vegan marshmallows for kids with dietary restrictions) Total cost of the event was: \$3,685 We budgeted \$3000 from Gaming grant + Donations (1\$) that were collected in the week before the event, and deposited \$896.60
  - A team of volunteers helped make and serve hot chocolate: Debby, Gigi, Lucia, Sherry, Sandy, Roz, Dejan, Eric, Fiona, Rachel, Yulia, Shailesh, Dipa, Melissa, Tanja. Thank you everyone!
  - Hot Lunch (Fresh Slice Pizza) was on Thursday, November 16 and it went well. It raised \$2267.93. Next hot lunch is on Thursday, Dec 14 th. The last day to order is December 10th. Please know there won't be late orders, no refunds, and if your child is sick let us know and you can come and pick up their lunch.
  - We are looking at bringing in new vendors. It's hard because of the number of kids. One of the options is splitting divisions, West and East and offering one vendor for East, one for west, and then switching them up for the next hot lunch. We will look at other options too.
  - We will try to book dates for January March so parents can order 3 hot lunches at once, which helps keep the processing fees down. And if the Grade 7 Graduation

Committee and Quebec Trip Committee decide to run some hot lunches we can add them to MunchaLunch so it's easier for parents to order everything at once.

o Fundraisers

Mabel's Labels update (a cheque to \$103.25 was issued and deposited (October), another cheque to \$68.55 was received and deposited (November), we will have another cheque issued in late December (current balance is \$79.49)

- Christmas Purdy's Campaign was launched on Nov 3, closed on November 27 th ; and submitted on November 28 th . Delivery will be in the week of December 4-8. We had sales of \$4,608 (product total before tax) and our 25% profit is \$1,209.60. Thank you everyone for supporting!
- Donations: while we try to have fundraisers that would appeal to most families, some families said they would rather donate money. We will be sending out a letter inviting parents to donate if they can and would like to. Some companies offer matching donations, especially during December.
- PAC Facebook Account –Principal checked with the school board, we got some guidelines, and we will work on it. Hopefully we can have it up before in January.
- Grade 7 Committee Neufeld Farms Fundraiser closed. The committee has not been formed just yet. Vanessa L. will provide more information.
- Quebec Trip Committee Poinsettia Sale Fundraiser closing today. Snack Sale will take place during lunch on Fridays, starting December 1 st in the East Gym. Items will be either \$1 or \$2. Mariah B. will provide more information.

#### 5.) Treasurer's Report by Florence Dompas (Treasurer)

- Pumpkin patch expenses \$3685; raised \$896.60. Originally budgeted for \$3000 and budget amendment approved on November 30, 2023 General Meeting to increase pumpkin patch budget for additional \$685.
- Hot lunch on November 16 raised \$2267.93
- Mabel's Labels fundraising has raised \$172.05
- Fundraising Income and Expenses for Grade 7 have been added to the PAC Financial Statement. As of November 30th, Grade 7 has raised \$693 from Neufeld fundraising.

A 20-30-minute presentation on Emotional Regulation and Supporting your child with open conversations - By the Deputy Superintendent with the Director of Instructions and other team members. Some Highlights were:

- Children learn through their surroundings how to regulate emotions. The frontal cortex part of the brain is still developing.
- How to talk to your children and how to talk to others when around your children.
- To develop the correct language/vocabulary to have open conversations with your children, read stories to your child to build emotional language.
- Model good behavior and stay calm as children learn from their parents/caregivers how to react to different situations.
- DPAC reps requested presentations should be shared with schools and school parents and follow up with additional workshops.
- Motion moved to elect 2 DPAC reps from Burnaby Central West region. One from Moscrop Secondary and one from Douglas Road were elected. There will be a follow up in the January 2024 meeting as to other open positions on the Executive committee.
- The DPAC vice-chair announced her willingness to leave the DPAC committee after January 2024 along with one other member so there will be two open positions
- Demand from many DPAC reps for DPAC committee members to share meeting minutes on a regular basis. Minutes from the meeting have not been shared since May 2023.
- Some show and tell happened at the end of the meeting
