1. Welcome & Land Acknowledgement

3. Principal's Report (Bruce Cornell)

- 1. School Org Update
 - a. 1070 students with new ones starting next week
- 2. Staffing
 - a. Mr. Wong has returned from his Educational Leave
 - b. Mr. Graham is filling in for Ms. Johnson until the end of February, Divisions 25
 - c. We are still looking for a replacement for Ms. Geary, Division 37, French Immersion
- 3. Basketball
 - a. The season started last week. Thank you to Mr. Hoffard, Ms. Davis, Ms. Dare and Ms. Custodio for helping coach the teams
 - b. We have over 100 kids playing or practicing!
- 4. Parking Lots
 - a. A reminder for the community that the Nelson Street parking lot is for staff only. It is not drop off or pick up location.
 - i. We encourage parents to park in designated spots and not block the roadway through the lot on Dover Street
 - b. We ask parents not to use the lot between the Welcome Centre

and DLRC building. With the construction and moving of the DLRC on the parking lot side, we have many district vehicles using the space.

- 5. High School Articulation
 - a. We are in the process of transitioning kids to their catchment high schools.
 - High schools are projecting full in our area and based on initial looks at numbers Cross and Out of District applications will be limited and most likely not have any students taken from the list.
- 6. February is registration Month
 - a. If you have a Kindergarten aged student, please register during February.
 - b. Please remember if registering for French Immersion, please register in the English Program first and then complete the French application.

4. Vice-principal's Introduction (Mike Wong)

"My name is Mike Wong and I have been an educator for 23 years. I have worked here in BC in both Burnaby and Vancouver, as well as spending 4 years teaching in Ontario. Most of my time has been spent in Secondary schools, teaching math, social studies and supporting students with diverse learning needs. Most recently, I worked on the District's Staff Development Team, providing professional development opportunities for staff in the areas of numeracy, assessment, educational technology and advanced learning. Before that, I was the Social Studies Department Head and Technology Liaison at Ecole Alpha Secondary.
